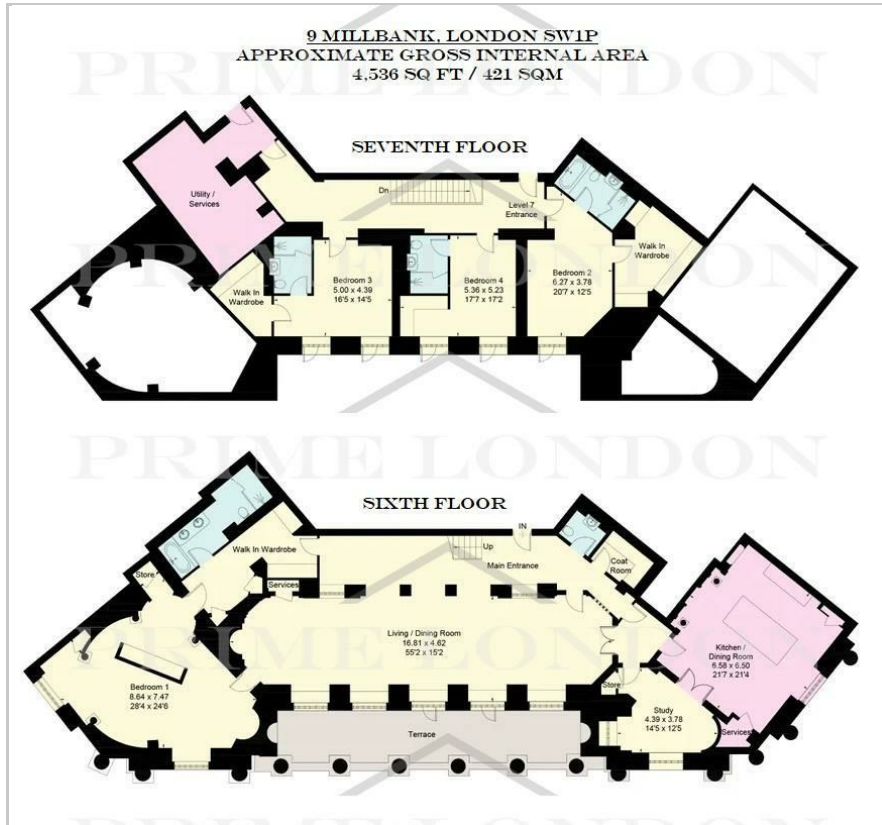

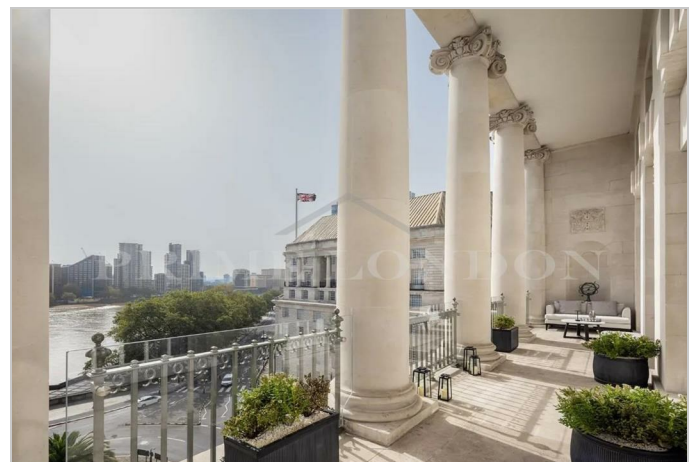
The Gainsborough is a stunning four-bedroom penthouse located in 9 Millbank, a Grade II-listed 1920s building along the River Thames. This exceptional home combines meticulously preserved original period features with contemporary design and modern amenities.

Spanning the sixth and seventh floors, the penthouse retains its original plasterwork and wooden paneling. The expansive living and dining area occupies most of the sixth floor, where large windows offer breathtaking views of the Thames and flood the space with natural light. The kitchen features high-end Gaggenau appliances and sleek cabinetry that contrast with the original wood paneling, and includes a spacious dining area.

The master bedroom boasts beautiful paneling and intricate cornicing, along with a walk-in wardrobe and a large marble-finished ensuite bathroom. Three additional ensuite bedrooms are exquisitely designed, with one guest bedroom also featuring a walk-in wardrobe. This floor is completed by a utility room.

A long terrace made from Portland stone, adorned with neoclassical columns, borders the main reception room. This striking space offers uninterrupted views of the river and the Houses of Parliament, and at one end, a historic sculpture by Charles Sargeant Jagger titled 'Chemistry' pays homage to the building's history.

The building is centered around a landscaped courtyard, providing a peaceful oasis in the city. The Millbank



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
