

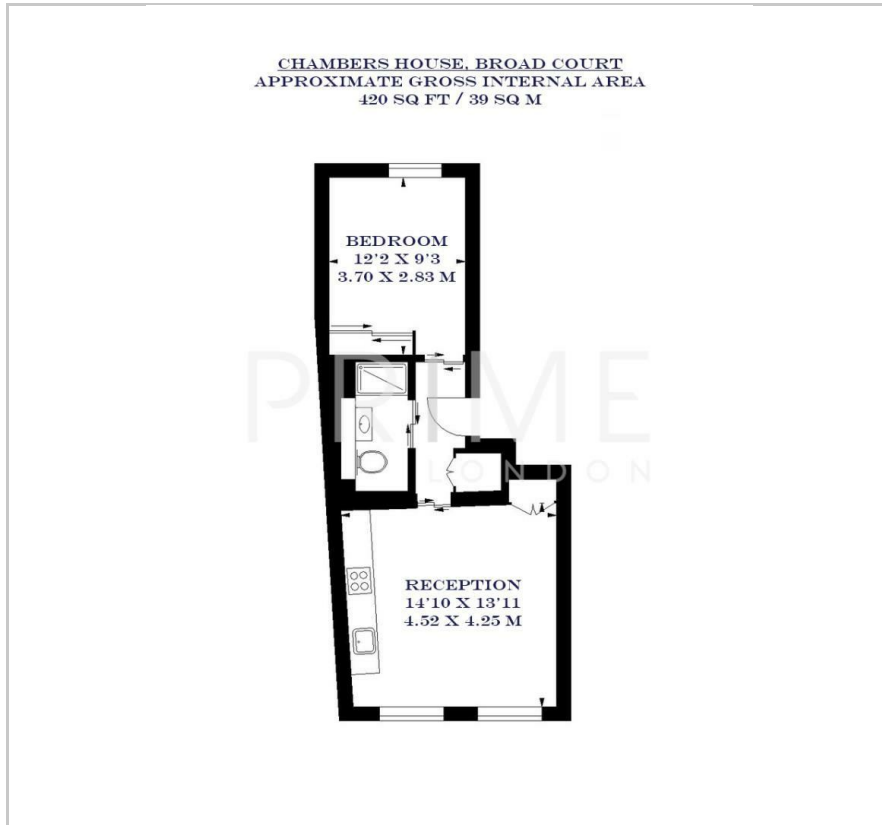

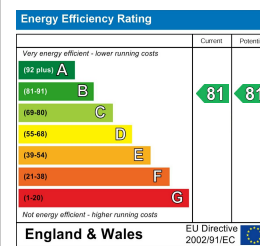
Floor Plan
