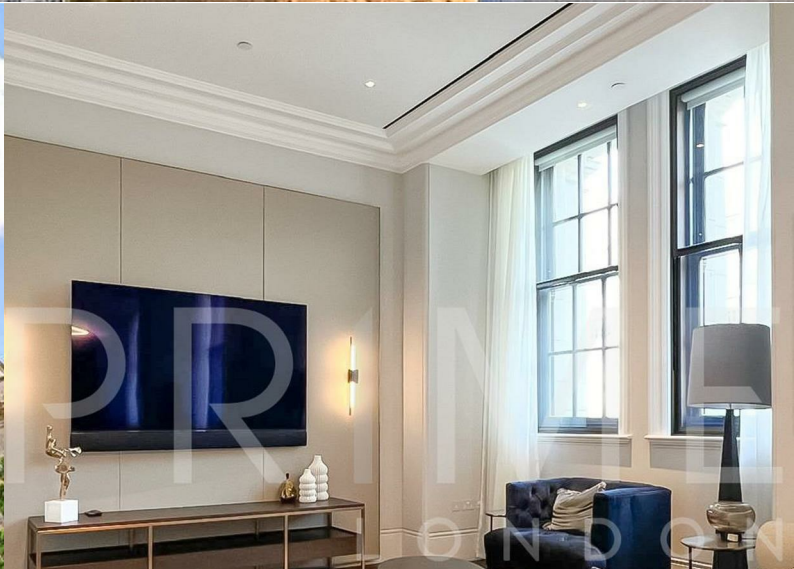




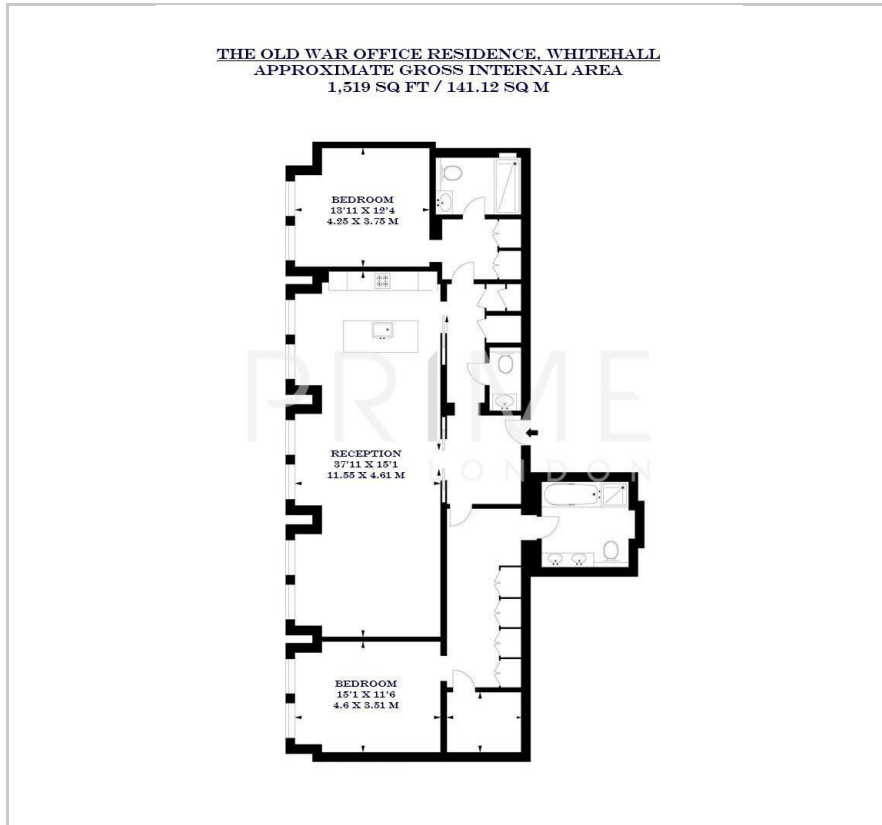

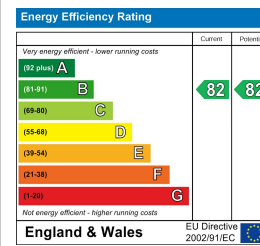
Floor Plan
