



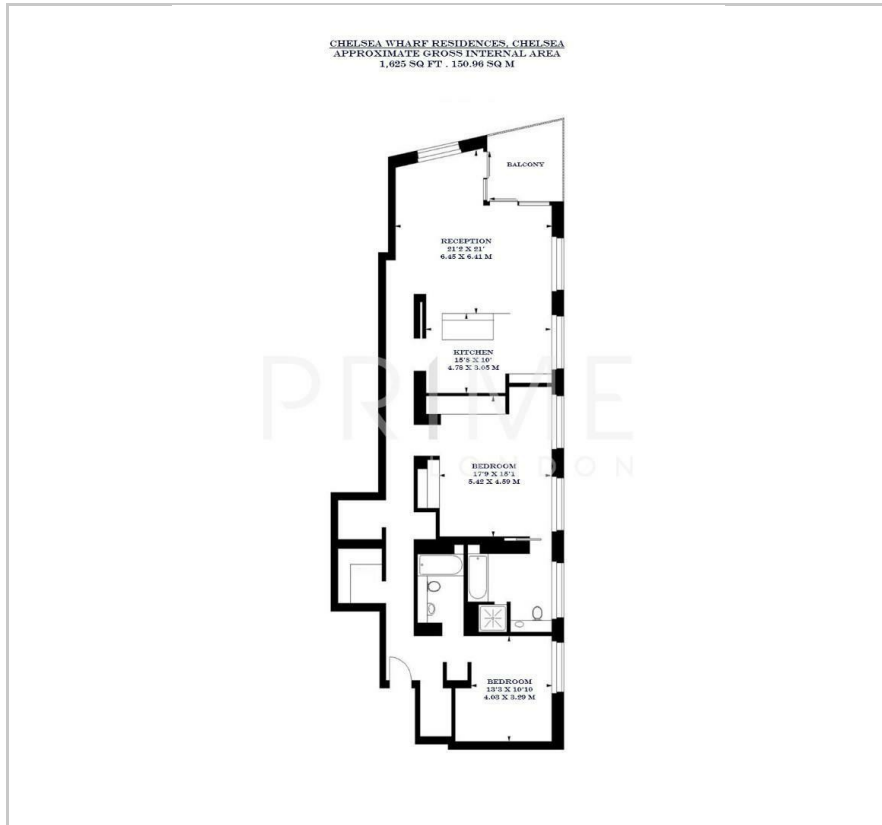

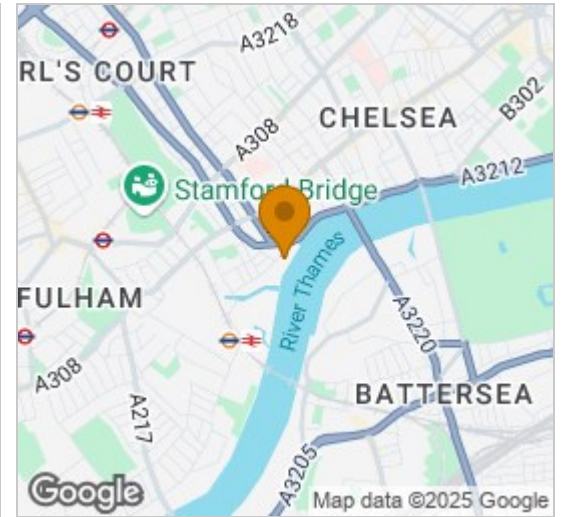

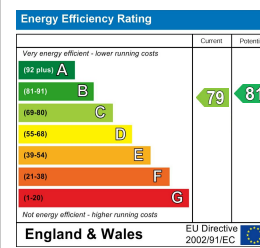
## Floor Plan



## Area Map



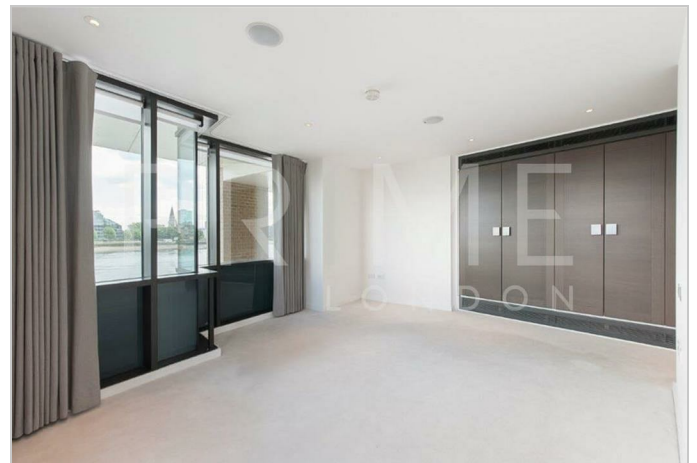
## Energy Efficiency Graph
