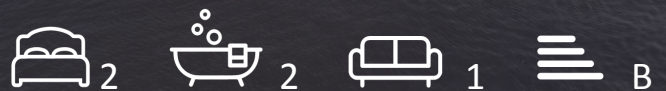

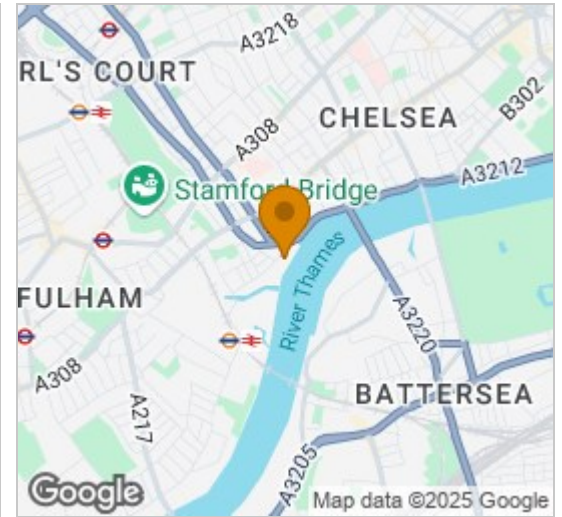

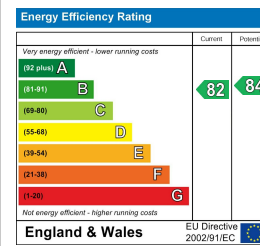
Floor Plan
